**Deadline for application and paper submission: 1 July 2021.**

The conference will include plenary section, oral presentation and poster sections during two days. Oral presentations may be held in English, Romanian and Russian. In Power Point and poster presentations the use of English language is mandatory.

Within 5 working days after receiving the Registration Form and the paper, each registered participant will receive an e-mail confirmation of registration for the conference. The organizing institution will publish the Proceedings of the Conference that will include the papers in English, as well as the Conference Program.

Papers will be presented in the form of oral communication or poster, and participants will be able to choose one of the two variants. Oral communications will be presented in PowerPoint and

the time allotted for each communication will be 10 minutes for the actual presentation and 5 minutes for questions and answers. The posters will have the A0 portrait (841 x 1189 mm) format. When making Power Point presentations (or other similar software) and poster presentations, the use of English is mandatory.

### **Drafting requirements:**

The text written in English will occupy 5-6 complete pages, A4 format, 210x297 mm, in the Word for Windows program, Times New Roman font 12 at an interval of 1.15 with paragraphs. Paper field: left - 30 mm, right - 15 mm, top and bottom - 20 mm.

The capitalized and centered title of the paper will be written in Times New Roman, font size 1, Bold. The words in the title will not be broken when transferred to another line. At one interval the institution, the city, the country, the e-mail address will be indicated, then at 2 intervals the text of the paper follows. Times New Roman, 12, Bold, centered.

Mandatory compartments: Abstract (Times New Roman 10, 1.15 line), Introduction, Materials and methods, Results and discussions, Bibliography (Times New Roman 12, 1.15 line). Bibliographic citations in the text will be made with the respective number from the bibliographic list in square parenthesis. The total number of authors of a work will not exceed 6, the number of works by one author will not exceed 2. The papers in English will be sent online, in separate, attached files, named after the first author and the number of the author's work: ex. Andriescu-1.doc.

Tables and figures: 1) title of table must be written with Times New Roman 11, Bold, centered; 2) figures, drawings, photographs will be included in the text and numbered in order of appearance in the paper. Title of figures, etc. will be written underneath (Times New Roman 10, Bold, centered).

The bibliographic titles will be listed in alphabetical order after the author's name and numbered.

### **Participation Fee**

The participation fee of 50 Euro will be paid upon arrival at the Organizing Committee. Students, PhD students and master students will pay 25 Euro. The authors of several papers will pay a single fee. The participation fee will cover the costs of preparing the Conference materials that each participant will receive, and that for lunch and coffee breaks.

**The participation fee does NOT cover the travel and accommodation costs of the participants.** Transport, accommodation and subsistence costs shall be covered by the participants.
